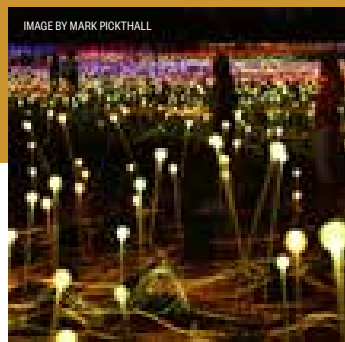


FEEL THE INSPIRING MAGNITUDE OF THE VAST NIGHT SKY, THE OVERWHELMING PRESENCE OF THE MAJESTIC ROCK. AS DARKNESS FALLS AND ULURU IS THROWN INTO SILHOUETTE, FIELD OF LIGHT ILLUMINATES. AS FAR AS THE EYE CAN SEE RHYTHMS OF COLOUR LIGHT UP THE DESERT.

The Field of Light art installation, a global phenomenon by internationally acclaimed artist Bruce Munro, has come 'home' to the place that inspired it - Uluru. More than 50,000 slender stems crowned with frosted-glass spheres bloom as darkness falls over Australia's spiritual heartland.

Pathways draw viewers into the installation, which comes to life under a sky brilliant with stars. The installation, aptly named Tili Wiru Tjuta Nyakutjaku or 'looking at lots of beautiful lights' in local Pitjantjatjara, will be in place until 31 December 2020.

Don't miss this once-in-a-lifetime experience.



FIELD OF LIGHT PASS

Your Field of Light experience begins with a convenient hotel pick-up and short transfer to the remote desert location.

As darkness has fallen, the 50,000 slender stems crowned with radiant frosted-glass spheres will gently bloom with rhythms of coloured light. Temporarily lose yourself in this monumental light installation as its pathways draw you in.

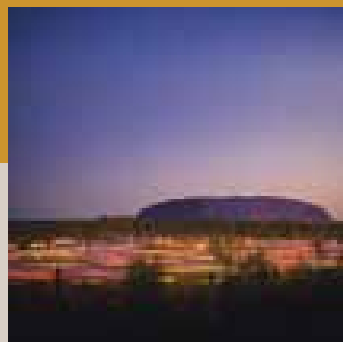
Duration Approx. 1 hour 30min including transfers

Covered by a sky brilliant with stars, Field of Light beckons you to explore and lose yourself momentarily in the rhythms of coloured light.

As darkness falls and the coloured lights of the 50,000 glass spheres gently come to life, join your table of fellow travellers for an exceptional three-course menu infused with bush tucker flavours. As the night ignites with countless stars, settle back and listen to our resident star talker decode the southern night sky.

Your host will provide insights to the art installation that awaits you, before you're invited to immerse yourself in the Field of Light, its pathways glistening softly with rhythms of coloured light, beckoning you to explore.

Bruce Munro is noted for his immersive site-specific installations that employ light to evoke emotional response, often in an outdoor context and on a monumental scale. Born in London in 1959, Munro's passion for light as a medium began in Australia. Munro visited Uluru in 1992 as he farewelled the country he'd called home for eight years. While camping at Uluru, he says: "The Field of Light installation was one idea that landed in my sketchbook and kept on nagging at me to be done. I saw in my mind a landscape of illuminated stems that, like the dormant seed in a dry desert, quietly wait until darkness falls, under a blazing blanket of southern stars, to bloom with gentle rhythms of light."
